Application can be had from the college office.

Sports Quota

At least one seat shall be reserved for sports candidates in each subject for the First Degree Programme. In addition to these seats, two additional seats, over and above the sanctioned strength, shall be created for allotment exclusively for sports candidates in FDP in each Arts and Commerce subjects. In postgraduate level, one seat is reserved for each subject.

Candidates who get allotment will have to report before the Principal concerned for admission on the dates notified by the University, with all documents listed by the same.

ADMISSION RULES 1.

- Generally students are admitted to the various courses only at the beginning of the academic year. 2.
- Any candidate found to have obtained admission by false representation, shall be summarily dismissed. 3.
- Ordinary TC will be issued only on the completion of the course. A student applying for TC will be required to clear his/her dues to the college.

RI

- Late fee will be charged if a student applies for TC, one year 4. after the completion of his/her course.
- Duplicate TC will be issued only on production of an affidavict 5. (Stamped Paper) signed by a judicial first class Magistrate. Fee will be charged for the duplicate TC (Rs.200/-)

RULES REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF FEES

As per G.O. MS 40 95/74 H.Edu. Dated 12-6-1974, the first installment of tuition fee and special fees from students of senior classes should be collected within a period of seven consecutive working days, beginning from the date of re- opening of the College. In the case of students of junior classes, the first installment of tuition fees due till the date of admission with special fees and caution deposits should be paid on or before the 7th consecutive working day of the month concerned.

- Tuition fee shall be collected from June to February of the 1. academic year in three equal installments. However, the fee for a year can be submitted in lump sum with the first installment.
- The miscellaneous fee prescribed shall be collected along with 2. the first installment in June.
- Subsequent installments shall be collected as notified on or 3. before the seventh working day of June, October and December, on specified days, for each class.
- If the specified day for fee collection is a holiday, fee due is 4. collected on the next working day
- A fine of Rs.10/- will be levied after the 10th day of the due date.
- If the fee and fine due are not remitted within 15 days of the 5. due date, the name of the defaulter will be put on the notice board. 6.
- The last chance to clear an installment of the fee shall be the date previous to the due date of the succeeding installment. 7.
- A defaulter shall not be allowed to attend another term without 8.
- remitting the fee for the previous term. A defaulter who does not clear all the dues by March (he / she) shall not be promoted to a higher class or presented 9. for the University examination.



- 10. A student admitted for one term only will have to remit the tuition fee for that term and the miscellaneous fees in full, the time of admission.
- 11. The rules are subject to change or modification according the Government/University orders issued from time to time

Re-Admission

With the special permission of the Principal, the student has to remit all the arrears of fees with fine. The re-admitted students will get the benefit of attendance only from the date of readmission. (Last opportunity is defined as the last working day previous to the date of the succeeding installment.
